



# TIPS FOR A GREAT TELEMEDICINE VISIT

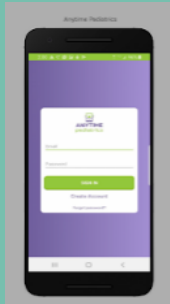

Visits work best if you use your smart phone, but a computer will also work if you use Chrome. I pads are often problematic.

Download the Anytime Pediatrics app for [ios](#) or [android](#) , or use the link on our [website](#) to register before calling for an appointment. Our practice code is 1177.

Log in up to 15 minutes before your appointment. Be sure that your audio and video are working.

Have your child with you in a well lit room that is as quiet and free of distractions as possible.

However we understand.... you're at home, so do your best. If we end up seeing your other children or your pets, it's ok (and even fun for us to see them!)

Tools to have available:

1. A thermometer
2. A flashlight or other light source (so we can look in your child's throat)
3. Your child's weight, or a scale
4. The name/location of your pharmacy

The doctor or NP will have you help with your child's physical exam. Have your child dressed appropriately to make it easy for us to see.

We might have you turn the phone to the child's throat, push on their belly, or have you take the temperature, among other things.

You will have a chance to take or upload pictures which are very helpful.

Feel free to ask questions and have your child do the same.

It might be fun for your child to show us their favorite toy or introduce their pet. Use anything you think will help your child feel comfortable with the visit.

We can not diagnose ear infections or strep throat, and we may ask you to come in for an office visit after the telemedicine visit, if we feel it is clinically necessary.
